MPEDA-RGCA has developed and standardized Artemia cyst processing technology for improving high hatching rate without affecting its nutritional quality. The Artemia cyst are naturally available from the salt pans & salt lagoons of Kanyakumari, Tuticorin, Ramanathapuram & Nagapattinam district and also from the states like Odissa, Gujarat, Rajasthan & Maharashtra. The high valued natural cyst resources are unutilized or underutilized due to lack of awareness, scientific knowledge, sophisticated equipment's for processing and preserving the cyst. The main objectives of this short-term training programme is to impart hands-on training on Artemia cyst processing and packaging to develop trained man power who could start Artemia cyst processing units.
